»» The Project Perfect World (PPW) Foundation is a humanitarian effort sponsored by the Association for Healthcare Resource and Material Management (AHRMM). Its goal is to provide needed medical care that is otherwise unavailable to underprivileged children throughout the world. Since its beginning in 1995, the PPW Foundation has sent medical teams around the world each year to perform maxillofacial, dental, orthopedic, and ophthalmic surgery on children.
